Guangfulin became a famous archaeology site when a farmer in 1959 accidentally discovered relics from GuangFuLin culture that thrived some 5,000 years ago.

Under construction since 2014 with opening schedule by end of 2017, GuangFuLin relics park have over 20 attractive sites such as the Museum of GuangFuLin Archaeological Remains which displays the unearthed pottery vases and others relics.

This museum of 8,000 m² also dubbed « the Jar museum » for its jar shape. It has been carved by a French artist who decided to use our tinted Thixopierre to imitate the appearance of GuangFuLin pottery vase.

The total cost of this project is estimated at 6 billions RMB (≈870Millions USD\$)
