### > Millenium Town Park

PAREX streetscape products played a central role in the transformation of a former Gas Works site in St. Helier on Jersey into a prestigious new town park.

The idea of a town park in St. Helier dates back to the mid 1990's when it was decided to transform the area of the redundant gas works, which was being used as a car park, into a neighbourhood park featuring a large expanse of hard landscaping and water features. Two local contractors – C A Frazier Group Ltd and Brenwal Ltd were chosen for the paving works by The States of Jersey.

The Landscape Architects for the project were Burns + Nice in London and the Consulting Engineers were Parsons Brinckerhoff based in Cardiff.

Approximately 5,000 square metres of natural stone Granite paving units were laid within the new town park and its' adjacent streets.

The paving scheme was very detailed and complex with high programme pressures.

The specification was written to allow for full vehicular access and a PAREX STREETScape WARRANTY was offered.

The bedding, bonding and jointing mortar requirements were met by specifying a number of PAREX streetscape materials to provide an overall solution for the hard landscaped areas.
